Course Summary



- > **Global Management** introduces students to the foundational concepts and basic applications of global business for profit & public and non-profit organizations, who conduct international business and domestic business activities.
- > **Journey to Korean Music** helps broaden students' understanding of Korean culture and supports their adaptation to Korean life and study through traditional Korean music.
- > **Global Culture and Understanding Communication** provides a comprehensive overview of the study of communication and culture, with a particular focus on its role in an increasingly interconnected and globalized world.

- > **Virtual Environment and Ethics** aims to enable students to take appropriate actions while working in cyberspace based on an understanding of the Internet and cyberspace and the ethics applicable to cyberspace.
- > **Korean Speaking 1** is designed for beginners who are learning Korean for the first time. The goal is to develop students' Korean communication skills, enabling them to engage in daily life and university activities.
- > **Korea/Korean Meet Through K-Culture 1** is designed to enhance students' understanding of Korea and Koreans by exploring characteristics of Korean society through movies and dramas.
