
- ISP courses are part of the regular semester courses, taught for German and international students

TRACK A: ENGINEERING

Your course selection is complemented by two mandatory courses in German language and culture. A research project in addition to or instead of the regular ISP courses is possible.

Our discussion-based classes give you plenty of opportunity for interaction as you explore a variety of theoretical and practical approaches to understanding how we live and how we do things.
