Grading system	1 = superior / 2 = above average / 3 = average / 4 = sufficient / 5 = fail/CR = no grade; class participation on pass/fail basis / AU = class audited At times decimal scaling is used for grades in between full numbers; i.e. each grade can be increased or lowered by 0.3; thus there is a grade 1.7 (also known as 2+), 2.0, 2.3 (also known as 2-) etc.
