- Benefits: safe environment, multicultural, relatively cheap cost of living, great location in Europe







Our Services for Exchange Students

Comprehensive Orientation and Tutoring Programs

- We take care of all logistics: dorm reservation, visa application documents & appointment in Dortmund, etc.
- Pick-up at Dortmund train station or on campus upon arrival
- Buddy Programs
- Academic Advisor for each student
- Welcome Week with different events / excursions in March & September
- Equal Opportunities Services: Special support for students with disabilities or illness

Pre-semester German Intensive Course

- March or September, 4 weeks
- Several levels
- No tuition fees for exchange students

Germany ticket for Students (Deutschlandsemesterticket)

- Valid on all local and regional trains & on public transport such as buses or subways throughout Germany (high-speed trains excluded)

Living on campus & in Dortmund

- Summer/Spring Semester: April - July
Winter/Fall Semester: October - February
(German Intensive Course in March or September)
- The university has its own train stop approx. six minutes from downtown Dortmund
- Student dorms on and off campus, affordable housing in Dortmund
- TU Dortmund University offers several cafés and student cafeterias
Expenses for food: approx. 300 € / month
- Subsidized meals in the cafeteria (lunch), including vegan and vegetarian options, a grill counter, salad buffet and an à la carte warm/cold buffet
- Bistros are open for breakfast and lunch “food fakultät” is open for fresh pizza and pasta for lunch or dinner

International Summer Program (ISP) - only for bilateral partner universities (not ISEP)

Summer study program: Students are integrated in regular summer semester courses and campus life with courses taught in English; project work possible on request

Two tracks: Track A: Engineering, Track B: Humanities

Expenses

Academic and language courses are covered through the exchange agreement between the student's home university and TU Dortmund University and the tuition that students pay there.

Mandatory service package includes

- Accommodation (student residences)
- Health & liability insurance
- Germany transportation ticket
- Sport ticket, cultural program and excursions
- Buddy Program
- Additional costs of living are approx. 300€ per month
